Fig. 1.10 is a left side elevation view thereof;

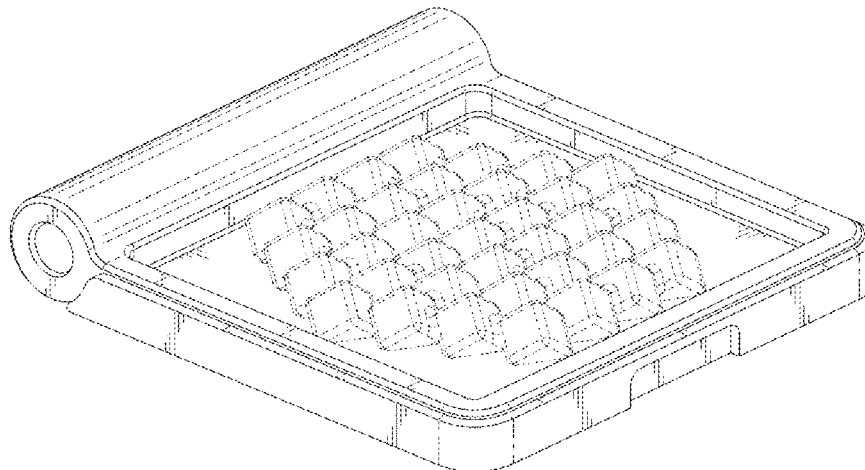
Fig. 1.11 is a front elevation view thereof;

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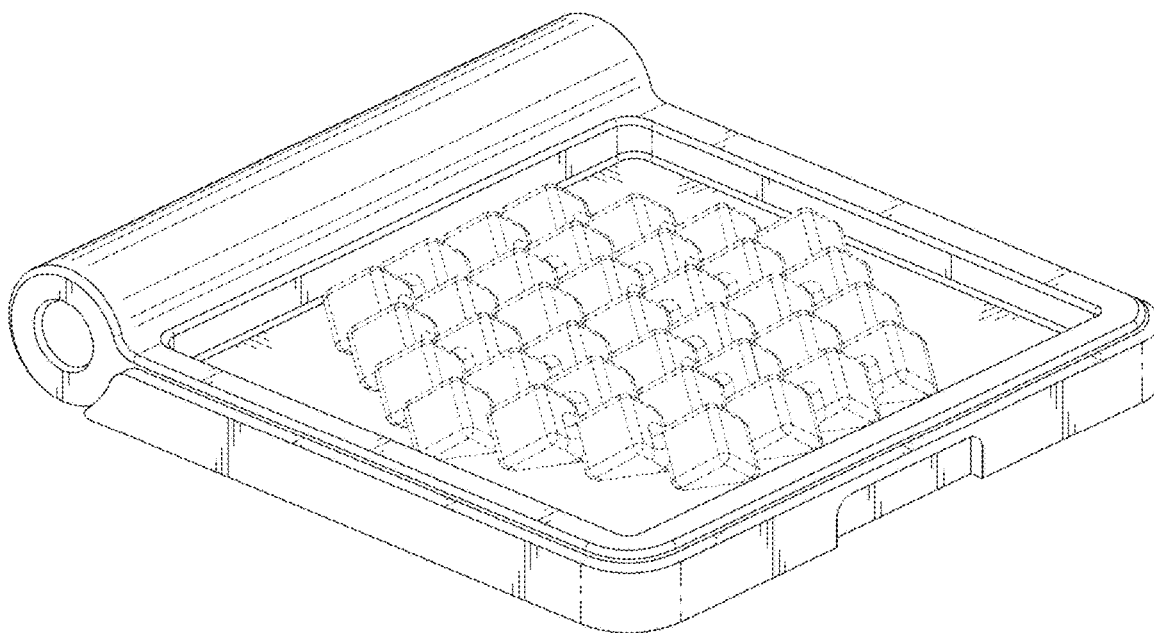
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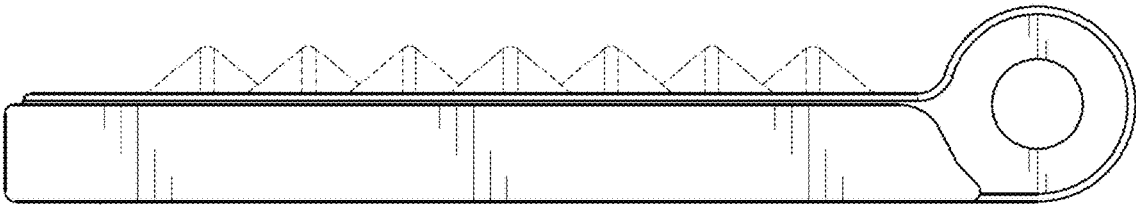
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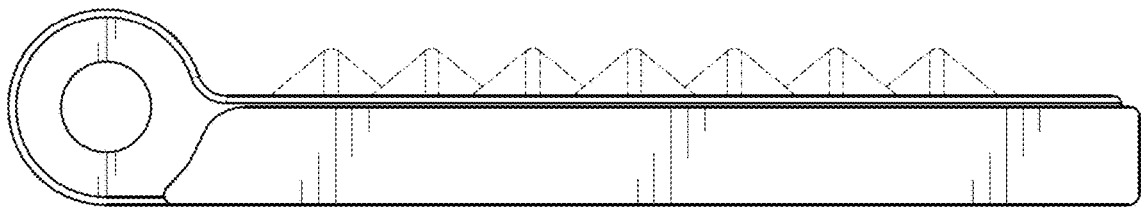
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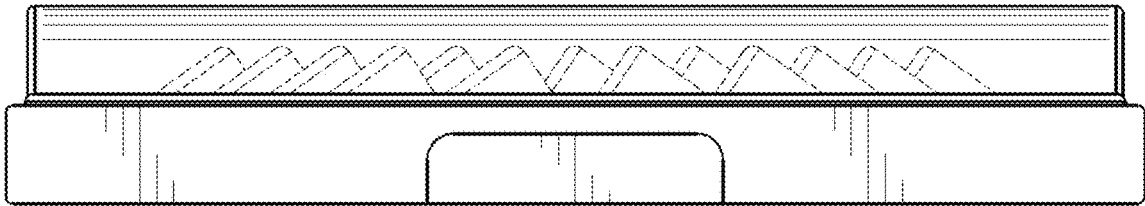
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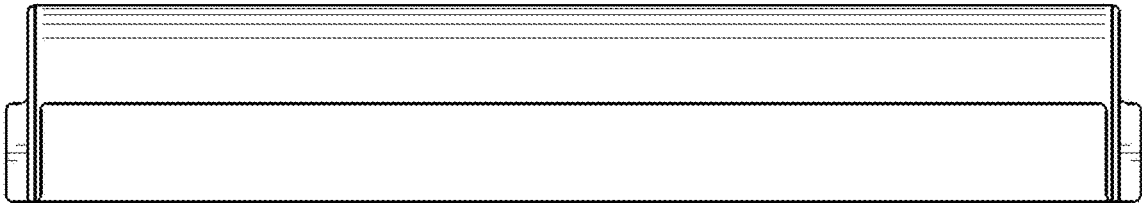
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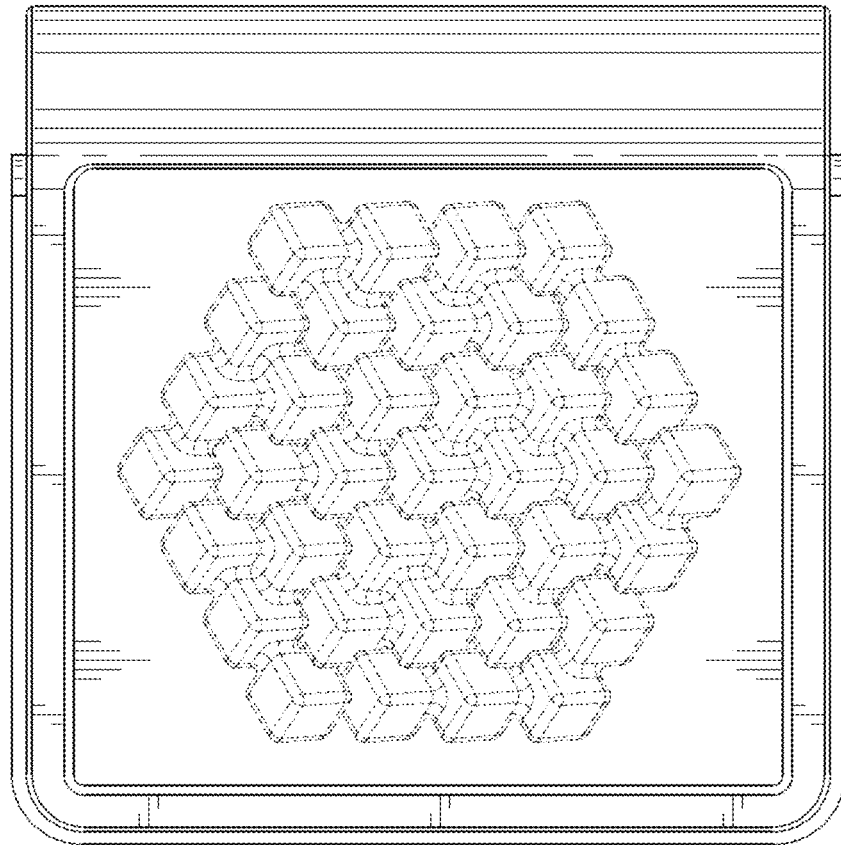
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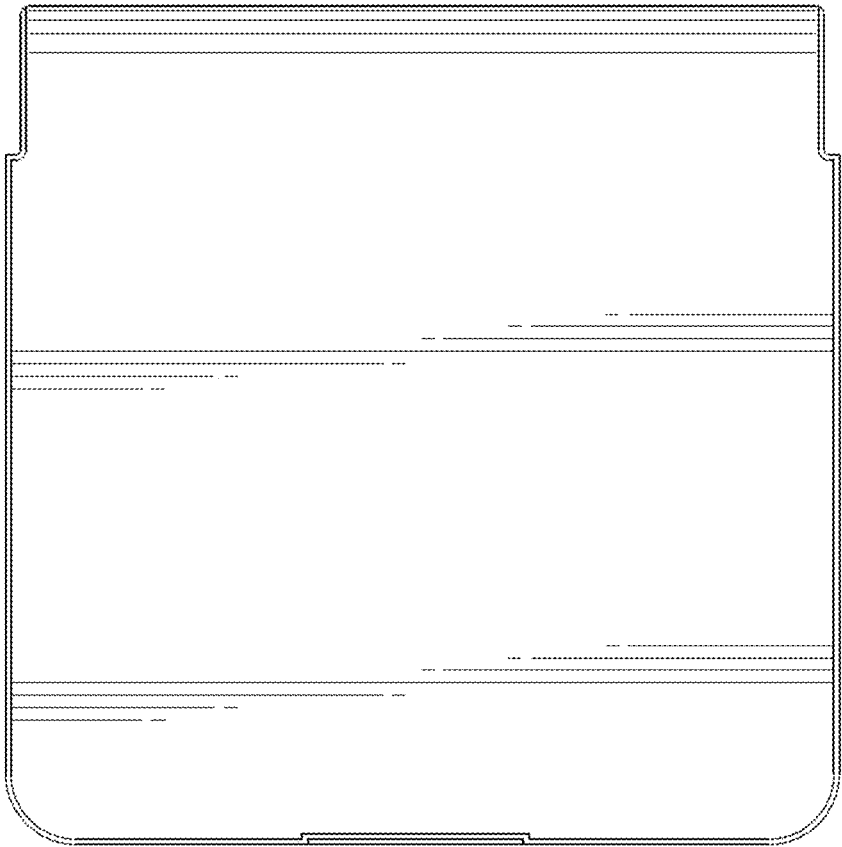
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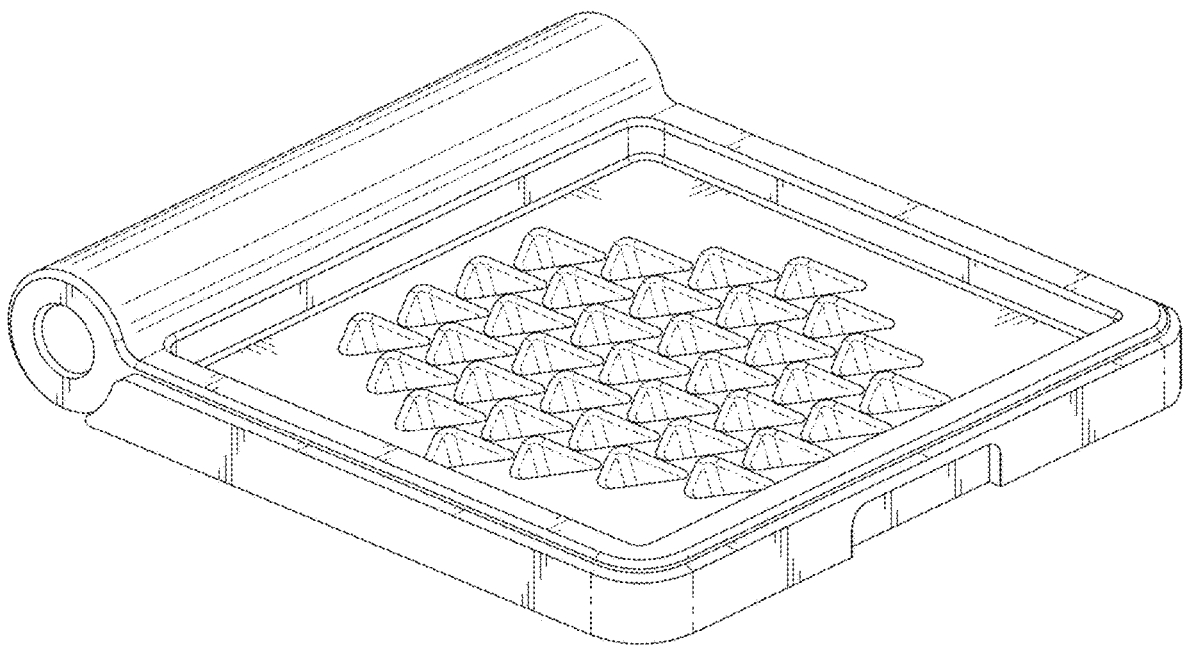

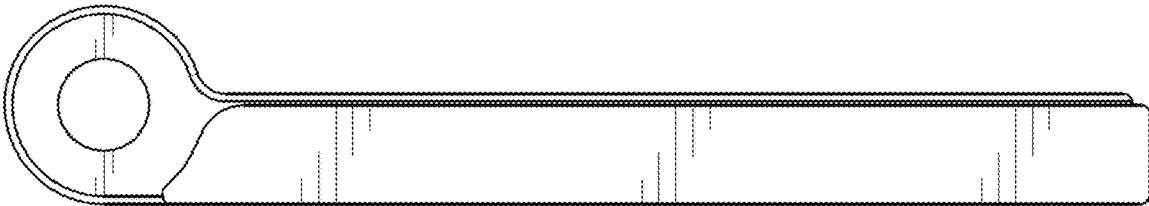
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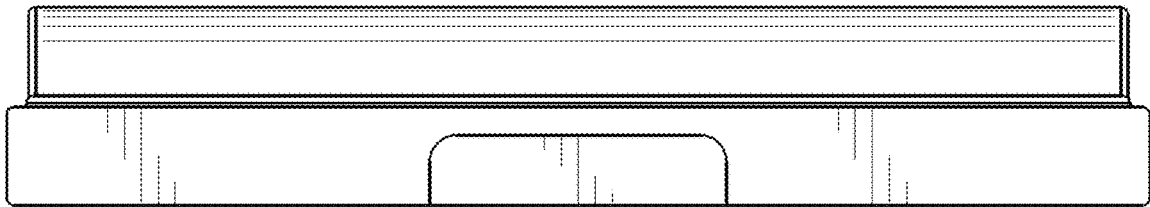
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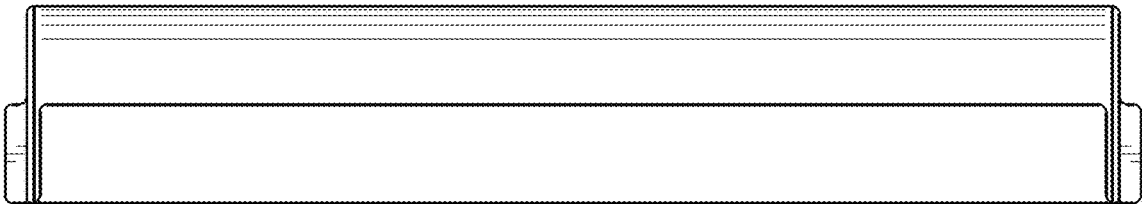
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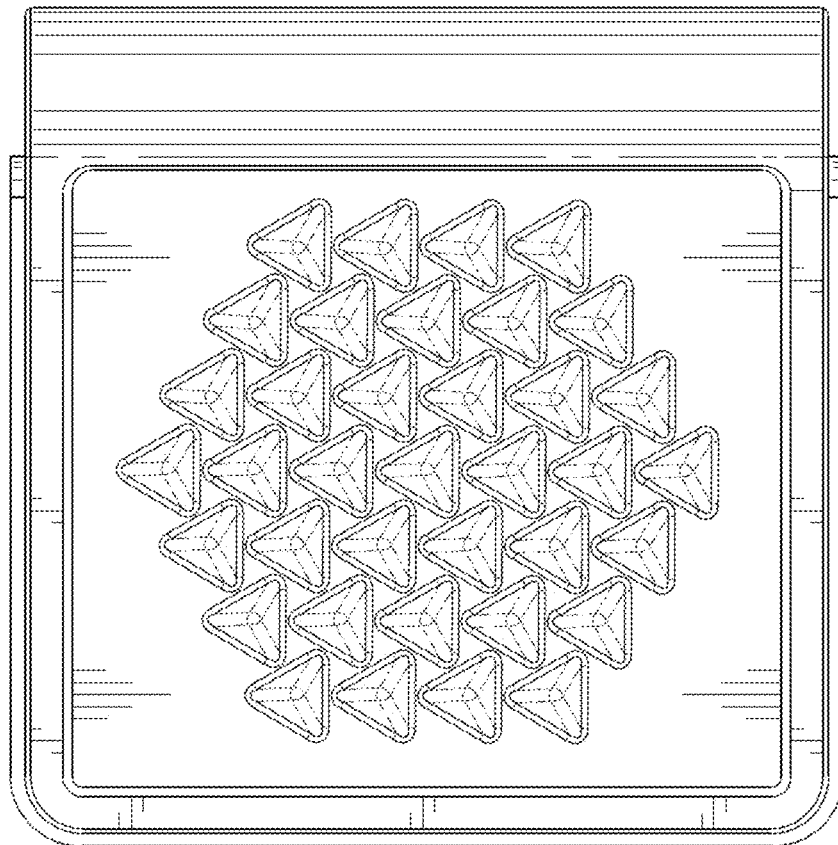
